*Unless there is rain, ceremonies will start in the gymnasium, and then there will be a procession to the church. You may wish to wear sunglasses to make it easier to walk and see your music.*

Hosanna, filio David	At beginning of liturgy.	All.	Enter after *, as usual.
<i>Christian will get palms for the choir, at the beginning of the distribution.</i>			
Pueri Hebraeorum, portantes	When distribution of palms begins.	All.	Cantors begin antiphon the first time, and all enter at *. Cantors sing verses. When antiphon is repeated, all sing the entire antiphon from the beginning (not just cantors).
Pueri Hebraeorum vestimenta	After previous antiphon.	All.	Same as previous.
<i>Choir will join procession at some place "in the midst of the people," two-by-two, first men, then women.</i>			
Occurrunt turbae & Cum angelis	When procession begins.	Male cantors.	On a psalm tone (same as last year).
Gloria, laus et honor	After previous (during procession).	All.	Cantors intone "Gloria, laus," and all enter at "et honor." Men or cantors on verse. When antiphon is repeated, all sing the entire antiphon from the beginning (not just cantors).
Omnes collaudant (1 <sup>st</sup> chant)	If time, after previous (during procession).	Cantors.	All cantors on antiphon. Male cantors sing odd verses, and women sing even.
Ingrediente	As procession enters church.	All.	Enter after *, as usual.
<i>Mass now proceeds, as usual, except... no Asperges; no Judica Me; no Gloria Patri at Introit; no last gospel.</i>
